ARTICLES

Article 2. The average cost-per-pupil for the preceding year as calculated in accordance with RSA 189:75, I(a) is \$25,841. ELA Proficiency: 79%; Math Proficiency: 41%; Science Proficiency: 58%.

Shall the Souhegan Cooperative School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling twenty two million five hundred ninety nine thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$22,599,250)? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be twenty two million five hundred twelve thousand five hundred ninety dollars (\$22,512,590), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Souhegan Cooperative School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only?

Shall the Souhegan Cooperative School District raise and appropriate the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the purpose of developing a long-range plan to ensure Souhegan High School remains educationally strong, student centered, fiscally responsible, and well-aligned with academic, technological, enrollment, facility, and other needs over the next decade?

This special warrant article will be a non-lapsing appropriation per RSA 32:7, VI and will not lapse until the development of the long range plan is completed or by 6/30/2028, whichever is sooner. This sum to come from new taxation. **Majority vote required.**

Article 8. Shall the Souhegan Cooperative School District adopt an open enrollment school program, designating Souhegan High School as open enrollment school pursuant to NH RSA 194-D, for the purpose of enabling the district to admit non-resident students to Souhegan High School, with one hundred percent (100%) of its eligible resident pupils permitted to attend Souhegan High School and zero percent (0%) of its resident pupils permitted to attend open enrollment schools located outside of the District, and further, to limit the number of non-resident pupils who may attend Souhegan High School under the provisions of RSA 194-D to no more than two percent (2%) of the total enrollment in the Souhegan Cooperative School District? **Majority vote required.**

Article 9. Shall the Souhegan Cooperative School District establish a Student Tuition Expendable Trust Fund per RSA 198:20-c, V for the purpose of paying student tuition as required by RSA 194-D, Open Enrollment School Program, and to raise and appropriate the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to be placed in this fund, and further, to name the Souhegan Cooperative School Board as agents to expend from said fund. This sum is to be raised from new taxation. **Majority vote required.**

Article 9 shall only take effect if Article 8 fails, and shall be null and void if Article 8 passes.
